The school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/CBSE and text 3. books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle Classes. The school will follow syllabus and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary/Sr. Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.

The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt from time to time.

- The section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.

13. Other conditions are as per Annexure 'A' enclosed.

- 14. Special conditions to be complied within three months:
  - i) The school is required to make arrangement of sufficient number of class rooms for Senior classes as stated in the letter and not to run any classes in afternoon shift.

ii) The school is required to provide more facilities for sports and games.

- iii) The school is required to add More books to the Library to cater the needs of +2 Students and Teachers.
